Environmental Policy

This Environmental Policy applies to CPI TMD Technologies Limited, located in Hayes, Middlesex, which employs approximately 160 staff in dedicated facilities of around 6,700 square metres. It meets the requirements of ISO14001:2015 and, following the acquisition of CPI TMD by The Transdigm Group in June 2024, it also complies with the TransDigm Environmental Policy GP-020.

CPI TMD is a supplier of radar, EW, communications, EMC testing, scientific, and medical applications to a worldwide customer base in the defense, commercial, and scientific sectors; this requires complex manufacturing facilities and an extensive supply chain. CPI TMD acknowledges that its purpose and context affect the local and wider environment and so is committed, through the implementation of, and self-declaration of compliance with, ISO14001:2015, to manage and continually improve its environmental performance.

CPI TMD recognises that operating within a sound environmental framework is essential for sustained profitable growth and is committed to the protection of the environment, preventing pollution, and meeting all applicable compliance obligations. This is supported by fostering a sense of commitment throughout the business.

- Ensure that our systems can detect and, where possible, prevent incidents that could have a detrimental impact on the environment.
- Maintain a system that will detect deviations from our environmental policy, procedures, and objectives, and that can respond with the appropriate corrective action.

We will ensure that this policy remains up to date. The Technical Services Manager is responsible for reviewing it annually and at other times when changing conditions or information may affect its validity.
